DECREE OF INCORPORATION

AND NOW, this 20th day of June, A. D., 1960, an application for a charter, and the Articles of Incorporation of the TRINITY EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH OF SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, under the "Non-profit Corporation Law", approved May 5, 1933, as amended, having been presented for approval to me, a law judge of the said County, accompanied by proof of the publication of the notice of such application and a certificate from the Department of State showing the registration of the proposed corporate name as required by law, I do hereby certify that I have perused and examined the said instruments and that I find the same to be in the proper form and within the provisions and requirements of the Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, known as "The Nonprofit Corporation Law", approved May 5, 1933, as amended; and that the purposes of the proposed corporation appear to be lawful and not injurious to the community. It is therefore ordered and decreed, that the Articles of Incorporation of the TRINITY EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH OF SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, be and the same are hereby approved and that upon the recording of the said Articles and this order, the subscribers thereto and their associates and successors, shall be a body politic and corporate in deed and in law by the name of the TRINITY EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH OF SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, which shall exist perpetually and shall be invested with, and have and enjoy all powers, privileges and franchises incident to a nonprofit corporation and be subject to all the duties, requirements, and restrictions specified and enjoined in and by the "Nonprofit Corporation Law", and all other applicable laws of this Commonwealth.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

BE IT KNOWN, that the undersigned, at least three of whom are residents of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and citizens of the United States, and all of whom are of full age, having associated themselves together for the purpose of organizing the TRINITY EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH OF SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, and being desirous of becoming incorporated in accordance with the provisions and requirements of the Act of General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, known as the "Nonprofit Corporation Law", approved May 5, 1933, as amended, do hereby declare set forth and certify as follows:

1. That the name of the corporation is the TRINITY EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH OF SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, and that said name has been registered with the Department of State within one year of the date of the application for this charter.

2. That the location and post office address of its initial registered office in this Commonwealth is Pleasant Valley, Springfield Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania.

3. The purpose or purposes of the corporation are: The support and promotion of public worship of Almighty God according to the Constitution of the Evangelical Lutheran Ministerium of Pa., in harmony with the doctrines and principles of the United Lutheran Church in America, and to conduct a public burial ground or cemetery not for profit other than is necessary for the proper maintenance of the burial ground or cemetery; and that this is a corporation which does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit, incidental or otherwise, to its members.

4. The term of its existence is perpetual.

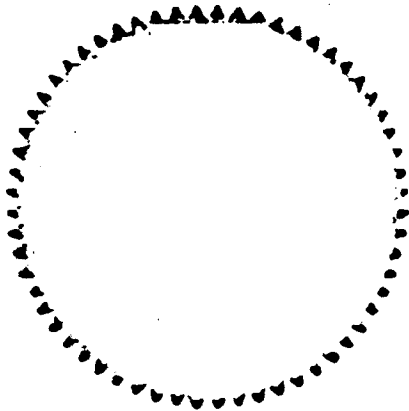

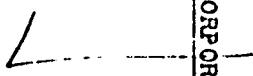
